Agreement to Participate in YMCA Programs.**

Participation in all YMCA programs, to include, membership, youth sports, camps, and child care. Physical activities involve certain inherent risks, and regardless of the care taken, it is impossible to ensure the absolute safety of the participant. A portion of membership activities, sports, camps and childcare activities require considerable coordination, agility, and a high level of cardiovascular fitness. They involve vigorous activity for as long as an hour or more, many quick bursts of energy/speed, and being alert to fast moving objects in a confined space. The purpose of this waiver is for you, as a participant or parent or guardian of a participant, to acknowledge the risk of participation in any program. The YMCA has developed a series of safety guidelines to reduce these risks to a minimum.

However, unlikely, a variety of injuries may occur to a participant. Some examples of those injuries are: 1. Minor injuries such as scrapes, bruises, strains, and sprains; 2. More serious injuries such as broken bones, cuts, concussions, and loss of vision; and 3. Catastrophic injuries such as heart attacks, paralysis, or other injuries that could result in death. These, and other injuries, sometime occur in physical activities as a result of hazards or accidents such as falls, slips, being struck by a ball or other sporting equipment, colliding with another player or field of play/activity objects, falling during activities/sports, or stress placed on the cardiovascular system.

To reduce the likelihood of injury to yourself and to other participants, all participants are expected to adhere to the following rules:

1. All participants should wear proper footwear/attire for the membership program, sport or activity.
2. All participants are expected to follow all safety rules and guidelines of membership, sports, child care, and activities.
3. All participants are expected to avoid actions that would endanger themselves or others involved in the program or activity.

I agree to follow the preceding safety rules, all posted safety rules, and all rules set forth by membership policy, instructors/coaches/counselors/teachers of the sport or activity. Furthermore, I agree to report any unsafe practices, conditions, or equipment to the management.

I certify that myself or my child 1) Possesses a sufficient degree of physical fitness to safely participate in YMCA membership, sports, camps, activities or child care. 2) Understands that I or my child should discontinue activity at any time that undue discomfort or stress occurs, and 3) Indications of any health-related conditions that might affect myself or my child's ability to participate in membership programs, sports, camps, activities, or child care will be verbally or written to inform the executive director, program or activity director or coordinator.
