Providing a safe environment is our top priority. We ask all SOPA Participants to adhere to the following policies:

- Prior to class, dancers (and parent dropping off child) will receive a health check when entering the building and be asked to leave if they have a temperature 100.4 degrees or higher or have done the following within the previous 14 days: Been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or traveled to a state currently on the Travel Advisory Quarantine list.
- Dancers ages 11 and under must be accompanied into the building by a parent or guardian.
- Please arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the start of class to avoid crowding in the lobby and halls.
- Dancers will check in at the Welcome Center and be asked to check out at the Welcome Center when leaving.
- After dropping your dancer off with SOPA Instructor In the lobby, parents must wait outside or in their cars for the duration of the class. When class is finished, dancers ages 11 and under will be escorted back to the lobby by a SOPA instructor where they can be picked up by a parent or guardian.
- Masks/face coverings are to be worn by anyone over the age of 2 who enters the facility. Instructors and class participants will wear masks/face coverings while participating in all class activities.
- Dancers must wash their hands prior to entering the studio.
- Designated social distancing spaces for each dancer have been marked on the floor of the studio. Dancers must remain in their designated space throughout the class period unless asked to move by the instructor.
- There will be no physical contact between dancers or between dancer and instructor.
- Dancers should use the restroom before or after class. In the case of emergency, dancers ages 11 and under will be escorted to the nearest restroom by the SOPA instructor and allowed into the restroom one at a time wearing a mask/face covering and strict handwashing enforced. Dancers ages 12 and up will be allowed to use the restroom one at a time wearing a mask and required to wash hands.
- Dancers who do not adhere to social distancing guidelines may be asked to leave the class.
- The adult and youth locker rooms are closed, and participants are asked to arrive at the YMCA ready for their dance class. Family changing rooms are available for emergency access only if needed.
- Please only bring what is needed for class (dance shoes, water bottle, etc.) to keep personal belongings brought into the studio at a minimum.
